



Q2 How would you rate the choice of speakers, presentation and discussion topics during ROW11?



Q3 Which discussion topics did you find most useful or productive?



Q4 Do you think additional Registration Operations Workshops are needed/useful in the future?



Q5 With regards to workshop's optimal audience and productivity, and if possible, what venue would you suggest for the next ROW session?




